Mums and Young Children Group

We run a unique support group for Mums and Young Children (0-3), offering a safe and nurturing environment for mums who are facing a variety of challenges.

The mums come together weekly, either on a Tuesday or a Friday morning, in a non-judgemental space lead by a psychotherapist, while their little ones are looked after by a Play Leader and a team of play volunteers.

We support the mums in a group setting, and in addition to receiving professional support and guidance, here they will find companionship and build a network of peers helping to reduce isolation.

Our unique approach

Working at the grassroots, we give parents support and practical guidance, empowering them to help themselves and face the future with confidence, breaking cycles of behaviour for future generations. All our beneficiaries are different and our support is tailored to the families that we work with.
